Annual Roaring Camp Train Outing (aka Train Day)
1 or 2 Train Rides ± Nature Walk ± Dinner

Enjoy the Redwoods from one or two historic railroads!

Santa Cruz Beach Diesel Train—**\$41.95*** (**\$27.95 child 2–12yo**). The Beach Train leaves Roaring Camp at **10:00 a.m.** to arrive at the Santa Cruz boardwalk at 11:00 a.m. Return trip from Santa Cruz at **12:00 p.m.**; arrives back at Roaring Camp at 1:00 p.m. **Note: Lunch in Santa Cruz**—purchase there or bring your own.

Redwood Forest Steam Train—**\$39.95*** (**\$24.95 child 2–12yo**). The Forest Train leaves Roaring Camp at **1:30 p.m.** for a 1½ hour round-trip to Bear Mountain, returning to Roaring Camp at 3:00 p.m.

*If adult does both train rides, the cost of tickets is **\$81.90 (\$52.90 for child)**. If we qualify for a group discount, Jane will refund \$ to you as appropriate for 1 or both trains.

Sign-up sheet available at Bows and Beaus Club and at Bows and Beaus Class. Checks payable to **Jane Bishop**, but give cash or check to either Jane Bishop or Ann Mayers **by 5 p.m. on Friday, June 7.**

Nature Walk!

Henry Cowell Redwoods State Park—A short, easy loop through the giant redwoods—after return from Redwood Forest train ride.



Dinner around 5:00 p.m.!

Dinner will be at the Empire Grille, 6155 Hwy 9, Felton. **Sign up, or RSVP by 5 p.m. on Friday, June 7, to Jane's home phone: (408) 356-7796.** Even if you don't do any of the rest of the day's events, it's all right to just come for dinner, but **be sure to sign up or RSVP** as described.

If you need to contact Jane on Train Day, June 24 only, you may call her cell phone (reception iffy): (408) 482-6613 . . . but NO texts!!!

Directions to Henry Cowell Redwoods State Park (see below for carpool option): Take Highway 17 toward Santa Cruz. After you go over the mountains, take **Exit 3** and turn right onto Mt. Hermon Road toward Felton. At Graham Hill Road, turn right. At next signal light, turn left onto Highway 9. Park entrance is a half mile down on your left.

Notes: You can park outside and walk a half mile into the park, or drive in and pay the parking fee. From the junction of Highways 85 and 17, **driving time is 35–40 minutes if there's no traffic delay; allow at least 1 hour.**

Parking by Visitors' Center and Store: Day-use parking fee for "regular size auto" is **\$10.00** (\$9 for seniors age 62+), or use your State Parks pass. **DO NOT PARK AT ROARING CAMP! Walk across tracks to depot to meet Jane and get train tickets from her;** she will have purchased them prior to this event.

Carpools from Town of Los Gatos parking lot, LEAVING by 8:30 a.m.: From Hwy 17, S of 85, take **Exit 20B** onto Hwy 9/Saratoga/Los Gatos exit. Between University and Santa Cruz Avenues, turn **RIGHT** into Town lot: Sign says Northside Lot, Free Limited Parking (large lot; "limited" means no overnights). Each rider should reimburse the driver for mileage, and riders will share the parking fee even if the driver has a State Parks pass. **Please sign up if you plan to carpool, whether as driver or rider.**
